



Back to School IEP Checklist

A new school year is a great time to review your child's Individualized Education Program (IEP)

Use this quick checklist to help you feel prepared!

REVIEW THE IEP

- ☐ I have a current copy of my child's IEP.
- ☐ Strengths, needs, and present level still reflect my child.
- ☐ I understand the annual goals and what my child is working toward.
- ☐ I know how and when progress will be reported to me.

SERVICES & SUPPORTS

- ☐ I understand the special education and related services in the IEP.
- ☐ The frequency, location, and duration of services is clear.
- ☐ I understand my child's accommodations, modifications, and supports.
- ☐ Transportation, assistive technology, or other IEP supports are in place when included in the IEP.

CONNECT WITH THE SCHOOL

- ☐ I know my child's teachers, case manager, and service providers.
- ☐ I have shared important updates that may affect my child's education.
- ☐ My child knows who to ask for help when needed.
- ☐ I know who to contact with questions about the IEP.

ONCE SCHOOL BEGINS

- ☐ My child is receiving the services and supports described in the IEP.
- ☐ Accommodations and supports are helping my child participate and learn.
- ☐ I am receiving information about my child's progress.
- ☐ I have identified any new concerns or needs to discuss with the IEP team.

Remember: You are an important member of your child's IEP team. You do not have to wait until the annual IEP review to ask questions or discuss your child's needs. If you would like to discuss your child's progress, services, supports, or educational needs, communicate with the school and request an IEP team meeting when appropriate.
